A youth cannot be accepted for participation in the Optical Optimism Leadership Conference (OOLC) unless the OOLC Youth Registration and Waiver Form is signed by the youth's parent/guardian and is complete.

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Associated Costs and Fees

The Optical Optimism Leadership Conference organizer, Dusek Vision Media LLC, charges on a "cost per student" format. It costs \$45 per youth attendee and covers all program costs, processing fees, materials, and lunch. Chaperones will not be charged for their attendance and will receive a lunch.

Event charges can be paid through the Dusek Vision online store. Upon submission of the school's registration pack, you will automatically be charged based on the number of youth attending the event.

Refund Policy

Due to the upfront costs associated with planning this event, all registration fees are non-refundable. In the event a registered student is unable to attend, a replacement from the same school may be substituted at no additional cost before August 20th, 2025

Terms and Conditions

By registering for the Optical Optimism Leadership Conference, all participants, parents/guardians, and school representatives agree to the following terms:

1. Eligibility

The event is open to high school students in grades 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th who are nominated or approved by their school or a designated sponsor.

2. Registration & Payment

Registration is not considered complete until full payment is received.

Registration payment for \$45 per youth attendee must be submitted by June 2nd, 2025. Late registration for \$60 per youth attendee will be in place effective June 3rd, 2025. Late registration payment must be submitted July 25th, 2025.

3. Refund Policy

All registration fees are non-refundable.

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This policy is necessary to cover non-recoverable event costs such as venue rental, materials, and catering.

Substitutions are allowed until August 20th, 2025. Please contact Dusek Vision Media LLC at info@dusekvision.com to make changes.

4. Code of Conduct

Students are expected to act responsibly and respectfully and represent their schools with integrity.

Disruptive behavior, disrespect toward others, or violation of event rules may result in removal from the event without refund.

5. Media Release

By attending, participants (and their guardians) grant permission for photos or videos taken during the event to be used for promotional purposes, unless a written opt-out is submitted prior to the event.

6. Liability Waiver

Participants and their guardians understand and acknowledge that participation involves some inherent risk. By registering, you release and hold harmless Dusek Vision Media LLC and the Arizona Western College, staff, volunteers, and venue from any liability related to injury, loss, or damages that may occur during the event.

7. Medical Emergencies

In the event of a medical emergency, event organizers will take reasonable steps to contact the listed emergency contact.

8. Inclement Weather or Event Cancellation

If the event is canceled due to circumstances beyond our control (e.g., extreme weather, natural disaster, or public health concern), the organizers will make reasonable efforts to reschedule. Refunds are not guaranteed but will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

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Chaperone Roster

The chaperone ratio for all programs must be 1:12 for minors 7 years and older.

Per Arizona Western College external events/camps/clinics involving youth:

Non-AWC organizations (those not acting on behalf of Arizona Western College) that organize youth program(s) on AWC campuses and facilities must ensure that their employees, associates, and volunteers who participate in the program pass a background check and are qualified as authorized adults.

The client will require and acknowledge that all adults, volunteers, or chaperones participating in the event are current in youth protection training and reporting. Training has to have been completed within the past 12 months During the event, any known or suspected child abuse or neglect must be reported to the AWC. The client must establish procedures that promote and ensure the health and safety of minors while participating in the program.
